Annual WEBELOS II Bicycling/Camping Trip

with BSA Troop 769

Friday, September 18 - Sunday, September 20, 2009

Boy Scout Troop 769 invites all 2nd year WEBELOS with a parent or legal guardian from area Cub Scout Packs to join us for a weekend of Bicycling and Camping along the C&O Canal towpath in Western, MD. The cycling trip will be 10-15 miles at a leisurely pace along hard-packed gravel. Support vehicles and personnel will follow the scouts to deal with any problems that might arise with them or their bicycles. At the end of the bike trip, the Scouts can explore the Paw-Paw tunnel, located nearby the campground where we'll be staying.

Troop 769 is sponsored by Nichols-Bethel United Methodist Church, located in Odenton, Maryland and meets on Tuesday evenings from 7:00 to 8:30 PM. The Troop has over 40 active scouts led by Scoutmaster and Eagle Scout Steve Fiorina, and 12+ Assistant Scoutmasters, many of whom are also Eagle Scouts. Ours is a "high adventure" troop with camping trips held monthly throughout the calendar year. Typical outings include canoeing (we own our own canoes and canoe trailer), bicycling, backpacking, rock climbing, whitewater rafting, and specialized BSA camps and camporees.

We encourage 2nd year WEBELOS with a parent or legal guardian to spend this weekend with us. We'll provide the tents and the food. Participating Scouts and adults will be responsible for providing their own bikes and appropriate head protection as well as personal gear, sleeping bag and mess kit with utensils (or alternative plates / bowls and eating utensils).
