Additional info:

- Each incoming scout is given a red Class B shirt, neckerchief, slide, 769 patch and shoulder loops.
- Weekly scout meetings are held every Tuesday night (all year long) from 7-8:15pm in the Fellowship Hall at NBUMC.
- Class A uniform consists of scout shirt and belt, jeans or shorts (no holes) and appropriate shoes.
- Class A uniform with neckerchief and merit badge sash are required attire at Courts of Honor and Eagle Courts of Honor.
- Class B uniform is worn Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- Courts of Honor are held in Spring and Fall every year.
- All parents are encouraged to assist with the troop. Possible volunteer roles include Assistant Scoutmaster, Troop Committee or as part of the adult leadership on trips. The committee meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of each month at 7pm at the church.
- Troop 769 is considered a “high adventure” Troop, with at least 1 trip scheduled per month. A scout is not required to attend all trips, but participation is highly encouraged. The Troop participates in a wide range of outdoor activities and scouts are encouraged to try everything.
